Contemporary Houses in Denmark are featured in **a+u 17:07** and the architectural traditions of the country are presented through 17 residential projects. The mood and lifestyle of the Danish people are combined into a theme of Melancholy, representing a thoughtful and pensive approach to life. Each featured house responds to the surrounding environment and this has influenced the design.
