Each wine is evaluated according to the Gambero Rosso *bicchieri* rating, with *Tre Bicchieri* awarded to the top labels. The guide is an essential tool for both wine professionals and passionate amateurs around the globe: it provides the instruments for finding one's way in the complex panorama of Italy's wine world.
