The Sansevero Chapel, located in the heart of historic Naples, is a treasure chest of baroque beauty, fascination, and mystery. This book presents the chapel's statues, crypts, and paintings in all-new photography. There is a chapter devoted entirely to *The Veiled Christ*, which goes deeply into the history of this important and moving work.
